Adventure and Golf: Enjoying the Great Outdoors



With fall color on the way, there are plenty of ways to enjoy the many outdoor activities that the Pocono Mountains offer. Here's a few ways to combine activity with play:

Water Sports and Golf: Head towards the Delaware Water Gap to see Bushkill Falls, enjoy kayaking or canoeing, or sign up for skydiving. Combine it with a round at Country Club of the Poconos, Fernwood Resort or Mountain Manor.

Fall Hiking and Hitting the Links: Promised Land State Park is full of beech, oak, maple and hemlock trees - perfect for a wooded hike for leaf peepers. Combine it with nearby Skytop or Buck Hill golf courses.

Shoot Away: Aim for the Pocono Manor region, where you can play at Pocono Manor golf course or Mount Airy, and then hit the shooting range. For those who'd rather be on the go, try the Pocono Manor stables, nearby.

A Good Hook: Woodloch Springs golf course offers stunning scenery. Combine with a fishing trip on Lake Wallenpaupack, where bass are king. There are excellent biking trails here as well.
